Intro. This second unit of John's Gospel (1:19–12:50) presents the Public Ministry of the Son of God to Israel. It is often referred to as the "Book of 7 Signs" because it presents seven of Jesus' miracles, which support His claims to be the Son of God, and Israel's Messiah.

- A. John the Baptist's witness to the priests and Levites (1:19-28)
 - 1. The meaning of "Jews" in John's Gospel (v. 19)
 - 2. The religious leaders' three questions (vv. 20-21)

- 3. John the Baptist's three replies (vv. 20-21) *John's replies grew progressively shorter*:
 - 1) "I am not the Christ"
 - 2) "I am not"
 - 3) "NO"
- 4. John the Baptist identifies himself as the "forerunner" of Messiah (vv. 22-28)
- B. John the Baptist's identity of Jesus at His baptism (1:29-34)
 - 1. Jesus is the Lamb of God (1:29a)
 - 2. Jesus takes away the sins of the world (1:29b).
 - 3. Jesus existed eternally (v. 30)
 - 4. Jesus is the Son of God (1:31-34)
