Jesus' First Cleansing of the Temple

John 2:12-25

Intro: Jesus' cleansing of the Temple revealed *His zeal for His Father's house* (Ps. 69:9), which was being profaned by the Jewish religious leaders (2:12-22). While He is rejected by the Jewish authorities, many, who saw His signs believed in His name (2:23-25).

I. Jesus Travels to Jerusalem for His First Passover 2:12-13

- A. The journey from Cana to Capernaum (v. 12)
- B. The journey from Capernaum to Jerusalem (v. 13)

- B. Jesus' disciples' application of Psalm 69:9 (v. 17)

III. Jesus Responds to the Jewish Leadership 2:18-22

- A. The Jews demanded a sign to authenticate Christ's authority (v. 18)
- B. The sign of Jesus' death and resurrection (vv. 19-21)
- C. The disciples, following Jesus resurrection, remembered this and believed (v. 22)

IV. A Note On Jesus' First Followers 2: 23-25

Applications:

- 1. If Jesus were to come to you this morning what would He do? Would He drive you away because of sin, or would He praise you for faithful service?
- 2. Remember that outward ritualism is not the same as an inward trust. May God help us to truly lay hold of Jesus Christ by faith.
- 3. Would you ask God to cleanse the Temple of your body (1 Corinthians 3:16), and help you to become all that He wants you to be?
