## Jesus Ministers Salvation In Samaria

The Samaritan Woman at the Well John 4:1-42

Intro: Following His initial ministry in Judea and Jerusalem, and possibly to avoid a premature confrontation with the Pharisees (4:1), Jesus returned to minister in Galilee. He felt compelled to pass through Samaria, as we shall see, to offer eternal life, in the form of "living water," to a despised Samaritan woman. The woman's witness led many of her townspeople to believe in Jesus, and to confess Him to be *the Savior of the world* (4:42).

C. The Samaritan woman's argument on worship (vv. 16-26)

**v. 24**—God is Spirit and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and truth. True worship of God must be according to His indwelling Spirit, and not based on material rituals.

vv. 25-26, 28— The Samaritan woman finally recognizes who Jesus is and accepts Him as her Messiah (v. 28)
