

Jonah's Psalm of Thanksgiving

(1:17-2:10)

Intro: As we learned last week, the LORD commissioned Jonah to take His message of love and forgiveness to the wicked people of Nineveh, but Jonah rebelled. He caught a ship sailing to Tarshish 2,000 miles in the opposite direction of Nineveh. The LORD hurled a great storm upon the sea to discipline Jonah. The sailors, following Jonah's instructions, threw him into the raging sea and it became calm. The LORD appointed a great fish to swallow Jonah, and he was in the stomach of the fish three days and three nights (v. 17). Chapter 2 presents Jonah's beautiful Psalm of Thanksgiving in which he praises God for sending the great fish to rescue him from drowning.

First Episode: Jonah's Commissioning and Flight (1:1-3)

Second Episode: Jonah and the Pagan Sailors (1:4-16)

Third Episode: Jonah's Psalm of Thanksgiving (1:17–2:10)

Note: Jonah's Psalm of Thanksgiving (2:2b-9) is framed by an introduction (1:17-2:2a) and a conclusion (2:10), both of which concern the "great fish."
