

Jonah Preaches At Nineveh

Jonah 3

Intro: After his frightening experience in the belly of the great fish, Jonah is given a second chance to obey God's mandate to go to Nineveh and deliver a message of God's impending judgment. Jonah delivers God's message of judgment and the entire city repents—they turned from their wicked ways and petitioned God for mercy. God graciously spared the people of Nineveh from judgment (3:10).
