Intro: In spite of the fact that the city of Philadelphia was built on earthquake prone ground, Christ commends the believers in the church at Philadelphia for standing firm for what they believed. The church in Philadelphia joins the church in Smyrna as being the only two churches to receive Christ's words of commendation for faithfulness, and no condemnation.

Third, Christ commends these believers for keeping His Word, and


Fourth, For remaining steadfastness in their Christian profession and service

First, Christian's enemies would be humiliated (v. 9)


