(John 4:1-26)

Intro: In our study of God's attributes, we have surmised that there is perhaps no more taxing a subject than probing the mystery of God. We concluded last week that the only way we as human beings can get to know God is for Him to reveal Himself to us. God's ultimate revelation to man was provided through His Son, Jesus Christ (Heb. 1:1-3). Jesus revealed one of the most basic and yet profound truths about God found anywhere in the Bible, God is Spirit (John 4:24).
