Living In Truth and Love 2 John

Intro: 2 John is another *little book* in God's Word with a *big message*. Believers are commanded to pursue love and to walk in the truth (vv. 4-6) and warned to exercise discernment and not invest in the work of heretical false teachers by showing them hospitality (vv. 7-11). Put briefly, "Warning: Do not help/house false teachers."

I. Introduction and Greeting 1-3

- A. Author: "the elder," or "old man"; John, the apostle (v. 1a)
- B. Recipient: "the chosen lady" (v. 1b)
- C. Reason for writing: "for the sake of the truth" (v. 2)
- D. John's greeting: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father, and from Jesus Christ the Son of the Father, in truth and love (v. 3)

II. The Command to Practice Love and to Walk in Truth (vv. 4-6)

- A. Commendation for Practicing the Truth (v. 4)
- B. Commandment to Pursue Love and to Walk in Truth (vv. 5-6; cf. John 13:34-35)

III. The Caution to Protect the Truth of Jesus' Divine Nature (vv. 7-11)

- A. Recognizing false teachers: they reject Christ's Deity (vv. 7-9)
 - 1. They *deny* Jesus Christ's incarnation–His coming in flesh (v. 7; cf. John 1:1, 14)
 - 2. They *claim* advanced knowledge (*gnosis*), i.e., superior revelation (v. 9a)
- B. Refusing false teachers: Do not support or greet them (vv. 10-11)

IV. Final Greetings (12-13)

Applications

- 1. If we say that we love God, then we will spend time with Him daily (in Word & in Prayer)!
- 2. If we say that we love God, then we will walk in the truth—live by the Holy Spirit's power!
- 3. If we say that we love God, then we will love one another (John 13:34-35; cf. 1 Cor 13:1-13)!
