 - The rejection of the nation (Matt 22:1-14)
- Jesus' teaching through *Questions*:
 - Question from *Herodians* about tribute to Caesar (Matt.22:15-22)
 - Question from *Sadducees* about resurrection (Matt 22:23-33)
 - Question from *Pharisees* about the Great Commandment (Matt 22:34-40)
 - Question from *Jesus*: how could David's son be his LORD (Matt 22:41-46)

- Three religious (Jewish) trials of Jesus: Annas (John 18:12-27), Caiaphas, (Matt 26:57-75) Sanhedrin (Matt 27:1-10)
- *Three civil (Roman) trials of Jesus*: Pilate (Matt 27:11-26; Luke 23:1-5), Herod (Luke 23:6-12), Pilate (Lk.23:13-25)
- The Crucifixion of Jesus at 9 AM (Matt 27:27-44)
- The Death of Jesus at 3 PM (Matt 27:45-56)
- The Burial of Jesus (Matt 27:57-66)

Saturday:

The Bible says nothing, but it was the day when the Apostles went to give their condolences to the Mother of Jesus, and that's why the scattered Apostles were again together on Eastern Sunday when Jesus appeared to them.

Eastern Sunday—The Power of the King—He has risen just as He said!

- Apparitions (Matt 28, Mark 16, Luke 24, John 20–21). John dedicates two chapters to Jesus' post-resurrection appearances (21–22).
