## Immanuel = God With Us!

(Matthew 1:20-23; Isaiah 7:14)

Intro: The angel's announcement to Joseph in Matthew 1:20-23, that Mary would conceive and give birth to Immanuel, the eternal Son of God, expresses the wonder of the Incarnation—that God "became flesh and made His dwelling among us" (John 1:14). Let's review 10 important prophecies/promises that God made concerning the coming of His virgin born Son, Immanuel.

## II. Ten Prophecies/Promises God Has Made

- 1. God's promise to Adam And Eve (Gen. 3:15)
- 2. God's provision of Seth (Gen. 4:1-26)
- 3. God's promise to Noah (Gen. 6–9)
- 4. God's prediction concerning Shem (Gen. 9:26)
- 5. God's promise to Abraham (Gen. 12:1-3; 15; 17)
- 6. God's promise to Isaac (Gen. 25:19-23)
- 7. God's promise to Jacob = *Tribe of Judah* (Gen. 49:10)
- 8. God's promise to David (2 Samuel 7:12-16; Psalm 89)
- 9. God's promise of the virgin birth (Isaiah 7:13-14)
- 10. God's promise of Christ's Kingdom Rule (Isaiah 9:6-7)

Conclusion: Don't miss the central message of Christmas. God sent forth His Son, who was born of a virgin. He came as the holy Lamb of God to take away the sin of the world (Isaiah 53). *"He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him"* (2 Corinthians 5:21). The focus of Christmas is to be upon God's gift of His eternal Son, Immanuel.
