

## All Israel Will Be Saved

(Romans 11:25-36)

**Intro**: In our last message in Romans 11:1-24, Paul argued that Israel's rejection of Her Messiah resulted in God's temporarily setting aside the nation as a whole, but He continues to call out a remnant of Jewish believers according to His gracious choice/election (11:5). Even though Israel has been rejected, when the full number of Gentiles comprising the Church has been realized, then God will turn back to save all Israel.

## I. The Nation Of Israel Will Be Saved: 4 Supporting Reasons (vv. 25-32)
