

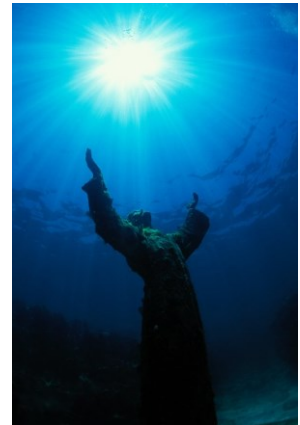
A Call For Thanksgiving

(Psalm 100)

Intro: This morning we want to devote our service to Thanksgiving. Before turning our attention to Psalm 100, the only Psalm in the Psalter that has the inspired title *A Psalm of Thanksgiving*, I would like for us to reflect upon what this day means. This is the one day out of the year that all of us should reflect upon our God, and give Him thanks for all the good things He has done for us this year. **Theme:** The Psalmist calls on all men to come before the LORD with praise and thanksgiving because He is God (vv. 1-3) and because He is good (vv. 4-5).
