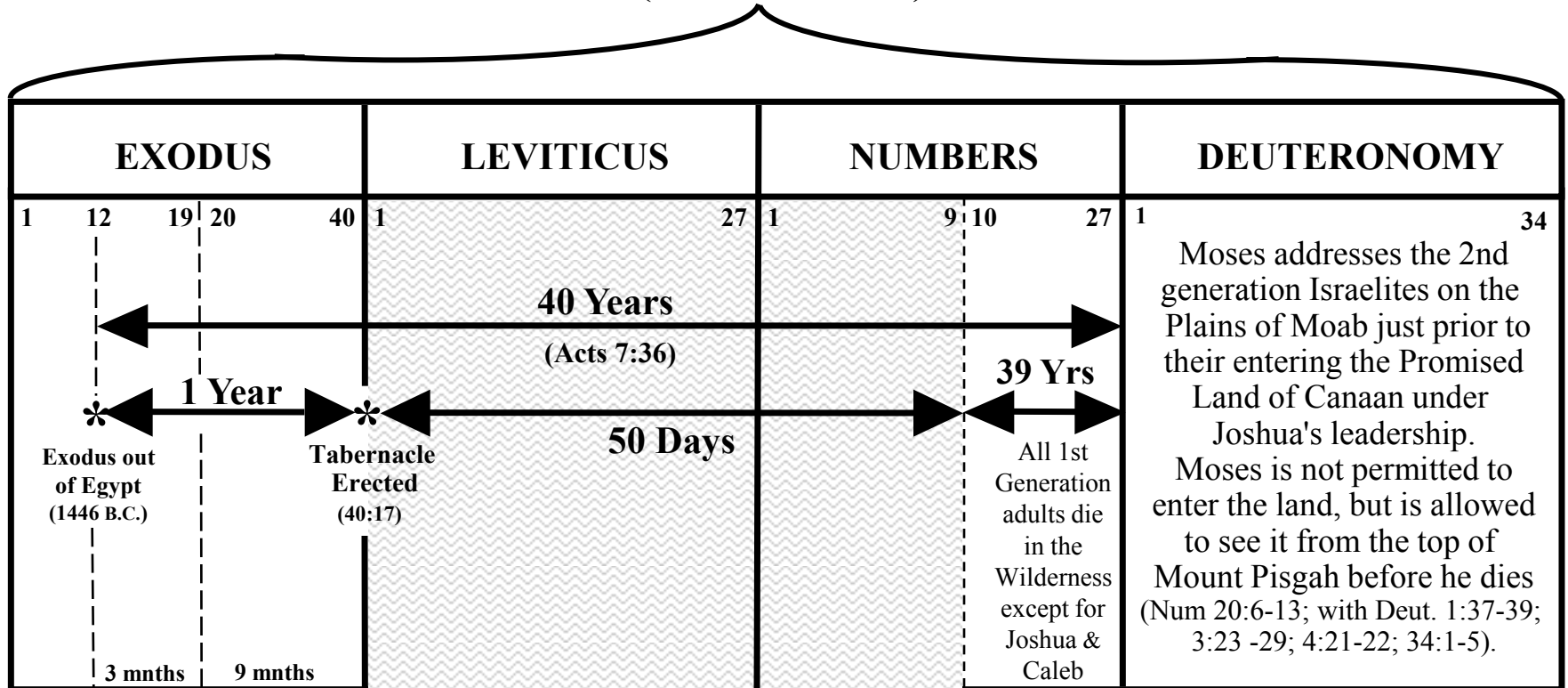

Moses addresses the 2nd generation Israelites on the Plains of Moab just prior to their entering the Promised Land of Canaan under Joshua's leadership. Moses is not permitted to enter the land, but is allowed to see it from the top of Mount Pisgah before he dies (Num 20:6-13; with Deut. 1:37-39; 3:23 -29; 4:21-22; 34:1-5).

Moses was to speak to the rock but in anger he struck the rock which offended the holiness of God!
