
Israel's History from the EXODUS to the Establishment of the Monarchy



Following the death of King Solomon in 931 B.C. the Kingdom of Israel divided in two. Jeroboam I lead the 10 Northern Tribes in a rebellion against Solomon's son, Rehoboam of Judah. This resulted in the founding of the 10 Northern Tribes, thereafter referred to as Israel. King Rehoboam of Judah was joined by Simeon and became known as the Southern Kingdom of Judah.
